Statewide Emergency Conservation Regulations In Effect

The following water-wasting activities are prohibited:



Overwatering lawns and landscapes such that excessive runoff flows into adjacent property walkways, or parking lots.



The application of potable water to sidewalks, and driveways is prohibited.



The use of a hose that dispenses potable water to wash a motor vehicle, except where the hose is fitted with a shut-off nozzle is prohibited.



The use of potable water in a fountain or other decorative water feature, except where the water is part of a recirculating system is prohibited.



Restaurants and other food service establishments may only serve water to customers on request.



Irrigating turf on ornamental landscapes during and 48hrs after measurable precipitation is prohibited.



Operators of hotels and motels must provide guests with the option of choosing not to have towels and linens laundered daily; notice must be prominently displayed.

Failure to comply with the water use restrictions may result in penalties in accordance with Part 15 of the District's Regulations Governing Water Service which include increased water charges and termination of water service.
