

REGULATIONS GOVERNING WATER SERVICE

PART 7 DISCONTINUANCE AND RESTORATION OF SERVICE

7-1 GROUND FOR TERMINATION – Any of the following shall constitute grounds for termination of service:

1. Violation of these Regulations;
2. Apparatus, appliances or equipment using water which are dangerous, unsafe or not in conformity with applicable laws or ordinances;
3. Unauthorized use of water or of the water system;
4. Where necessary for the District to protect itself from fraud or illegal activities;
5. Delivery of water from a meter to any property not described in the application for service to that meter without a written permit from the District.

7-2 AT CONSUMER'S REQUEST – A consumer may have its service discontinued by notifying the District at least 48 hours in advance of the desired date of discontinuance.

7-3 RESTORATION OF SERVICE:

7-3.1 GENERAL PROVISIONS – A consumer whose service has been discontinued may have it restored by making application and by paying a charge per the General Managers discretion as provided for by these Regulations.

7-3.2 UNAUTHORIZED RESTORATION – No person shall turn on water at the meter once it has been shut off by the District, or interfere with or remove a meter from any service connection.
